

Directions to Clissmann Horse Caravan Base at Cronybyrne from West Wicklow

If you are travelling to us from the West of Ireland and are planning to drive the scenic route across country instead of on the Motorways, you will come via the Wicklow Mountains and the village of Laragh.

To travel across the Wicklow Mountains you take the R756 from the village of Hollywood in West Wicklow. This road is known as the “Wicklow Gap” and will bring you to Glendalough.

After about 30 - 40 minutes on the R756 you will come to a T junction with signs to the right for Glendalough and to the left for the village of Laragh.

Take the LEFT to Laragh.

When you arrive in Laragh you will see Lynham’s pub on the right. Turn RIGHT directly in front of the pub going in the direction of Rathdrum.

Driving approx. 1 km, you will pass signs for the woollen mills on your right and a row of bed and breakfasts on your left.

There is a fork in the road with the L6086 on your left and the road to Rathdrum on your right which goes over a small stone bridge.

Take this LEFT before the stone bridge on the L6086.

Drive about 10 – 15 minutes and you will pass Cronybyrne Courtyard on your right.

We are the second entrance on the RIGHT after that.

We have a large semi-circular entrance with big stones either side and you should also be able to see the caravans in the field.
